1. All abstract must be submitted online only, through the e-mail address: conference.bcsir@gmail.com
2. All abstracts must be submitted in English, in Microsoft Word format, in a single page within 250 words (page size: Letter 11"x8.5", margin: top, bottom and right side 1", left side 1.3").
3. The title of the abstract should be in CAPITAL LETTERS, 12-point, Times New Roman, single spaced, centered, bold.
4. Name(s) of the author must be typed in 12-point, Times New Roman, single spaced, bold and centered. First and middle name in abbreviated form while the last name should be fully spelled out.
5. The name of the presenting author should be underlined, and the name(s) of corresponding author(s) should be indicated by an asterisk*.
6. Full address must be typed in italics, and E-mail address of the corresponding author(s) should be provided in 12-point, Times New Roman, single spaced and centered.
7. Text of the abstract should be in 12-point, Times New Roman, single spaced and justified. Abstract Figure(s) may be included (if necessary) within stipulated area.
8. The abstract must contain original research material, must not be published or presented at any other national or international congress prior to this conference.
9. Only corresponding author of accepted abstract will receive the confirmation via submitted E-mail and announced in the conference website.
10. Accepted abstract would be published in a special issue of Bangladesh Journal of Scientific and Industrial Research (Bangladesh J. Sci. Ind. Res).
